REPORT TO TOWN COUNCILLORS

AGENDA ITEM 10 – Defibrillator at the Town Hall

AIM

1. To consider installing a defibrillator on the Town Hall.

BACKGROUND

2. The Town Council has been contacted by a would be benefactor to install a defibrillator on the Town Hall.

DISCUSSION/ COMMENT

3. The would be benefactor has enquired with the Conservation Officer at Shropshire Council regarding the appropriateness of such an item being placed on a listed building and advises that there are no objections. Confirmation of the approval would need to be sought.
4. The proposed location is under the arches (see picture) facing into the covered market area.
5. The would be benefactor advises that they are likely to be able to engage a local electrician to connect the defibrillator to a power source (of the Town Hall). The Town Council would need to have assurances that the work is carried out to appropriate standards.
6. The defibrillator would have a small ongoing revenue cost attached to it (electricity supply) but that is likely to be minimal. Should it be used then there will likely be costs to re-site/ recalibrate/ repair before it can be available to use again.

RECOMMENDATION(s)

7. It is recommended that the Town Council RESOLVES:

Subject to the necessary assurances of the Conservation officer; to agree to the siting of a 'gifted' defibrillator on the Town Hall.
