Christmas Light Switch On- Notes of Meeting 19th April 2022

The Property and Grounds Administrator invited all members of the Events Committee to attend a briefing/update on the preparations for Christmas Light Switch on, on the 19th April 2022.

Councillors, Chris Aked, Rachel Connolly, and Ian Wellings were able to attend.

The Project plan was discussed with it remaining very similar to that of 2021.

Councillors proposed some modifications/ fire tweaks that were incorporated into the project plan. Ideas include expanding the stalled area to include Central Court Shopping Centre.

A number of essential tasks have already been completed, including:

- First Aid booked
- Stage Entertainment/Mc booked

Quotes are being obtained to improve our PA system to cover the lower end of the High Street.

Applications for Stalls, Caters and Bars will be advertised once the Road Closure is confirmed with Shropshire Council.
