RW/2022 11th OCTOBER 2022 REPORT TO TOWN COUNCILLORS AGENDA ITEM 17 – REPAIRS TO BUS SHELTERS

AIM

1. To agree to the recommended glazing repairs to 3 bus shelters and agree for the expenditure to be taken from Earmarked Reserves.

BACKGROUND

2. The Town Council is responsible for several bus shelters around town.

DISCUSSION/ COMMENT

- 3. The Outdoor & Property Manager and the Senior Maintenance Operative have recently reviewed the condition of 3 bus shelters located in High Town: 1 x High Street and 2 x Old Smithfield.
- 4. Quotes were requested from 3 relevant companies.
- 5. Only one company was prepared to quote for work in Bridgnorth.

FINANCE

6. The quote is for a total of £7,000 plus VAT and covers the following:

Repair & Refurbishment of: x3 existing Bus Shelters (as per images provided by email 13/09/2022)

Scope of Work –

Bus Shelter 1 – x 1 replacement glass panel

Bus Shelter 2 - Full re-glaze in PET side & rear panels plus new bench seats (capacity 16 people)

Bus Shelter 3 - Prep & redecoration plus new glazing (There is evidence of some corrosion from the images. Prep & paint subject to condition of steel work, no provision for welding on site)

Price is based upon one continuous site visit.

RMI to supply chapter 8 barriers and pedestrian signage only - no provision for specialised traffic management or permit applications.

- 7. The quote has been reviewed by the Outdoor & Property Manager and is deemed to be reasonable due to the nature, expertise and amount of work that is required.
- 8. There is currently £8,680 in Earmarked Reserves. This relates to historic grant funding before 2012 which was originally for the purchase of a new bus shelter (general

- consensus is that it was for Whitburn Street although no evidence can be found due to the age of the grant).
- 9. This was subsequently amended to include repairs to other bus stops maintained by the Town Council.

RECOMMENDATION(s)

10. It is recommended that the Town Council RESOLVES:

To agree to the repairs as per the attached quotation and that the expenditure be funded from EMR 328, £7,000 plus VAT.
