## <u>AIM</u>

1. To discuss and agree any potential changes to the non-statutory service levels undertaken by Council for FY 2023/2024.

## **BACKGROUND**

- 2. The Finance Committee met on Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> November 2022 to discuss the budget for 2023/2024.
- 3. The Committee were presented with a report detailing possible service changes for financial years 2023/2024 and 2024/2025 given the current financial climate.
- 4. Reductions have already been made in areas that can be influenced, stationery, postage, waste disposal, equipment, cleaning contract, re-cycling etc
- 5. Contracts are regularly negotiated to achieve best value.

## DISCUSSION/COMMENT

- 6. The current budget shows a precept requirement of £747,437.
- 7. Based on the Council Tax Base (CTB) figure for 2022/2023 4572.09 (the new figure will not be available until later in the financial year) this would mean a projected Band D equivalent of £163.60 an increase of £13.93 9.4%
- 8. Increases have not generally been applied to the income streams. In the current financial crisis, it did not seem prudent to do so.
- 9. Roughly speaking, based on the current CTB figure, each £4,572 'saving' results in a £1 decrease (or 0.67%) in the Band D equivalent
