### Haydn Festival Grant Application - Supplementary information

Mr Proudman from the Haydn Festival was asked to clarify the following points;

- We can see there is £400 income from schools. Which schools are paying?
- Could we have some more detail on the £360 accommodation and £40 transport.
- From what we can see, there is enough money without a grant to cover this, is this not the case?

The following reply was then subsequently received from Mr Proudman on behalf of the Haydn Festival

*The £400 was an "expectation", estimated by what the school's had contributed at a previous Festival concert.*

*In the past four primary schools have been involved with attending the special Festival concert.*

*The accommodation budget proposal is based on the four musicians hotel charge for one night.*

*The £40 cost is for transporting the four musicians, plus instruments, to the four, schools.*

*The hoped for School's contribution will not cover the overall cost of the four musicians fees totalling £1200.*

*I trust that this information is sufficient for Councillors to support our application for funding in order for this project to realised.*
