Town Hall Security Bollards - Under the Town Hall

Aim

- To choose and accept an appropriate quote for the replacement security bollards (RAM resistant) under the Town Hall.

Background

- Two manual retractable bollards were installed some time ago under the main entrance arch to the Town Hall.
- These were installed for the safety of the public who walk beneath the Town Hall, including the traders which operate the market. I am of the understanding that a vehicle accident occurred some years ago which led to a vehicle crashing into the open market, which resulted in the erection of the two RAM safety bollards.
- It is understood that the two bollards have been non-operational for around 2-3 years, with both bollards having broken locking mechanisms and the left bollard missing a handle.
- The current bollards are no longer being manufactured so replacement and future maintenance on them is no longer possible.

Purpose

- The purpose of these bollards is to protect the stall holders and members of the public from danger during the operating times of the market, under the Town Hall.
- There has previously been an incident where a driver lost control of a car and drove into the market. On this occasion there has not been a fatality.
- This reduces the risk of any incident occurring in the future where potentially there could be injury to members of the public and stall holders.

Discussion/Comment

- Three quotes have been obtained for the two replacement bollards. From contractors site visits, the outer cases which sit in the ground do not require fixing / replacing.

All three bollards are RAM certified. Ram-raiding refers to an act where a driver rams their vehicle into a building so they can easily gain access to the property and steal or vandalize whatever they can.

There will be a requirement for quote two and three to be installed by the BTC maintenance team. Please note that this would add greater onus responsibility on the Town Council should any claim/accident should occur in the future and the Town Council may need to prove competence for installation.
