0228/2324 ITEMS FOR NEXT AGENDA

Members discussed the following items for inclusion on a future agenda:

- SALC and the difficult decisions being made by Shropshire Council regarding services and potential discussions with Town & Parish Councils on the discontinued services.
- Shropshire Council Budget Consultation and the 16 things to be ranked in order of preference as services.

The Town Clerk was asked to circulate the current running list of items for a future agenda and to consider adding the list on the agenda for future Town Council meetings.

0229/2324 PRECEPT AND BUDGET SETTING FOR FINANCIAL YEAR 2024/2025

Members debated the draft budget approved at the meeting held on the 16th January 2024.

Councillor S Barlow entered the meeting.

The Town Clerk confirmed that the borrowing application had been sent to the Department of Levelling Up, Housing and Communities. There had been some additional questions raised following the submission and the Town Clerk confirmed these had been answered, still pending a decision from the Department of Levelling Up, Housing and Communities.

Members debated the risk of approving the precept without the final decision from the Department of Levelling Up, Housing and Communities for borrowing.

It was proposed by Councillor N Cooper, seconded by Councillor A Chetter Unanimously agreed by all Councillors

RESOLVED: to approve the recommendations for the setting of the precept for financial year 2024/2025 as follows:

- i) To agree the summary budget (Appendix A) for financial year 2024/2025. (Precept of £798,161 and Band D equivalent of £171.26, percentage increase of 9.98%.)
- ii) To approve the issuing of the precept, requiring Shropshire Council to pay Bridgnorth Town Council £798,161 (seven hundred and ninety-eight thousand, one hundred and sixty-one pounds) to meet its expenditure for the financial year 2024/2025.
- iii) For the precept paperwork to be prepared and signed by the Town Clerk and Mayor, and sent to Shropshire Council.

The Mayor and the Town Clerk signed the precept paperwork. Meeting closed at 7.07pm

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
